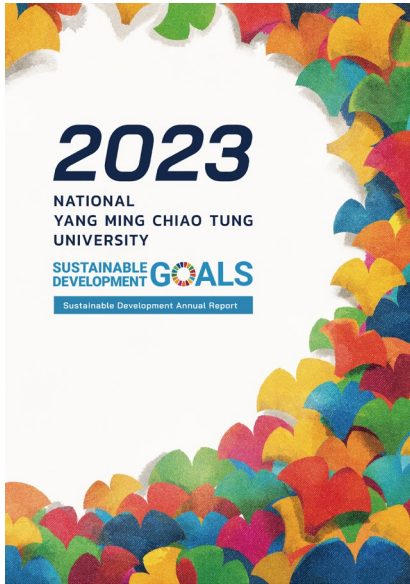

Letter from President



Formed by a university merger on February 1, 2021, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU) has continued to carry forward the ideologies of the two universities: "absorb the new to look far ahead, and work pragmatically" and "learn and implement with both a benevolent mind and heart." NYCU is committed to providing high-quality education and contributing to the global community, playing a key role in this wave of sustainable development. In the face of climate change and sustainable economic transformation, NYCU continues to promote sustainable education, establish sustainable talent cultivation strategies, incorporate sustainable concepts into courses and research projects, strengthen students' and the faculty's awareness of pursuing sustainable development goals (SDGs) and incorporate SDGs into its vision for campus governance, creating a friendly campus in the spirit of sustainability and demonstrating NYCU's capacity for sustainable development.
