

2025 QS World University Rankings - Citations per Faculty **NYCU Ranks 1st Domestically**

The UK Higher Education Survey Center (Quacquarelli Symonds, QS) announced the "2025 QS World University Rankings" this June. A total of 1,503 schools made the list for 2025, an increase from 1,499 in 2024. Twenty-seven universities and colleges from Taiwan were included, with NYCU ranking 219th globally and 4th nationally. Notably, NYCU achieved the highest national rank in the "Citations per Faculty" metric, which evaluates the impact of research output. This indicator uses the Scopus database to calculate the number of citations per faculty member for papers published over the past five years (2018-2022) and cited over the past six years (2018-2023), excluding self-citations.

2024 Global Views Magazine Taiwan Best University Rankings **NYCU Recognized as a Leader in the "Information and Communications Technology" Field**

The "Global Views" Taiwan Best University Rankings 2024 were announced on July 2nd, with our university ranking 3rd among comprehensive universities, the same as last year. Additionally, it was recognized as the leader in the "Information and Communication Technology" field. The survey evaluated universities based on six major aspects, encompassing a total of 45 detailed indicators: social reputation (20%), with 11 indicators; academic achievement (20%), with 7 indicators; teaching performance (16%), with 8 indicators; degree of internationalization (15%), with 8 indicators; industry-academia performance (19%), with 7 indicators; and financial indicators (10%), with 4 indicators. Among the 45 detailed indicators, NYCU secured first place in 6 categories: SDG impact, enrollment rate, the proportion of income from sources other than tuition fees, the average amount of academic research project funding per faculty member, the weighted ratio of full-time faculty receiving awards/honors, and the number of Taiwan patents.
